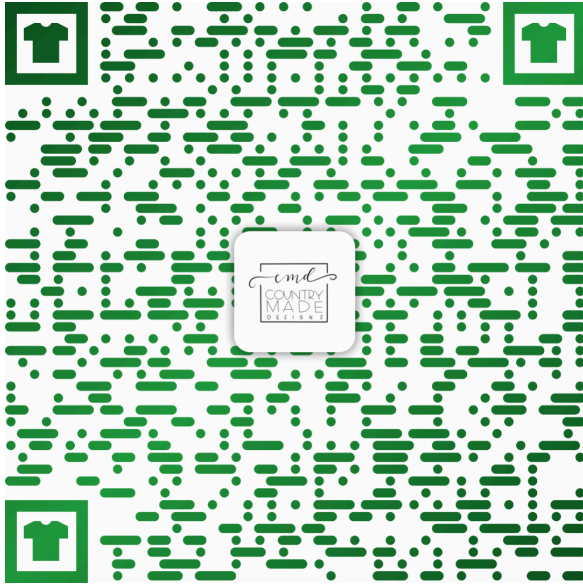
Students will bring costumes to school to put on after lunch. Costumes must be school appropriate.
