- The PTO appreciates everyone who submitted a committee form. If you have not turned in a form and wish to help on any committee, please complete the

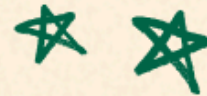
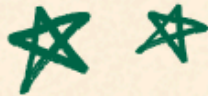
form and send it back to school ASAP. We are still in need of co-chairs for the following committees. If you are interested in being a co-chair, please reach out to any of the PTO Officers.
